- Isha will be moderating a panel at the International Dairy Foods Association [ProFood Tech](#) conference, **April 4 - 6 in Chicago, IL**.

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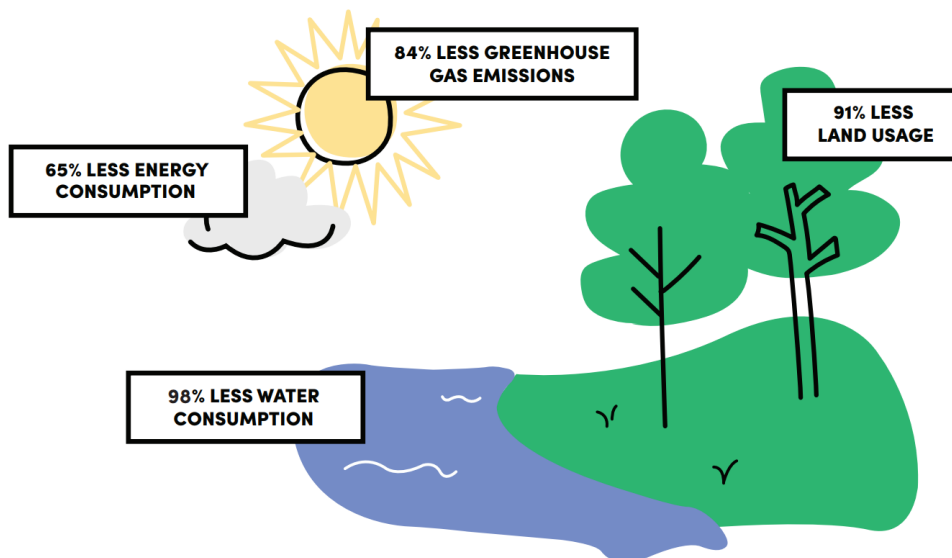
